

Experience the beauty of the White Mountain National Forest on horseback. With rides for beginners, intermediates, advanced riders, as well as pony rides for youngsters, a horseback ride in the beautiful outdoors surrounding Loon Mountain is a memorable adventure for everyone.

All trail rides are limited in size, and reservations are recommended by calling (603) 745-6281, ext. 5454, or (603) 745-6938. The Equestrian Center is tucked in the woods on the west end of Loon Mountain, and is open during our summer and winter seasons.



## Summer Season Days and Hours of Operation:

The Equestrian Center will open weekends starting Saturday, June 4, 2005, offering one- and two-hour trail rides only. The Equestrian Center will open daily starting June 25, 2005.

July 4 Equestrian Center Hours: The last rides of the day will be at 11:00a.m. on July 4. The horses will be participating in Lincoln-Woodstock parade in the afternoon. Be sure to see them!

## TRAIL RIDES for children age 8 to adults:

The Two-Hour Private Trail Ride is an exciting option for riders of any ability. This morning ride leaves Loon Mountain stables at 9:00 and 9:15am, and reservations are recommended. You won't forget this experience as you walk, trot, or canter (depending on rider's ability) through cool wooded trails along the mountainside of Loon to the summit of South Mountain, overlooking the towns of Lincoln and North Woodstock.

The One-Hour Walking Trail Ride is a leisurely one-hour guided trail walk for novice or "infrequent" trail riders. The ride travels over gentle wooded trails alongside the Pemigewasset River.



The One-Hour Intermediate Trail Ride is for more experienced riders and involves walking and trotting.

Pony rides are available daily from July 2 through Labor Day Weekend, from 10:00am to 2:00pm at the Equestrian Center for children of any age.

## HONEYMOON RIDE

Starting July 2 through Columbus Day Weekend, enjoy a two-hour ride with your new spouse. Private and romantic, your guide will take you to a secluded spot, where you can toast each other with sparkling cider served in champagne glasses. We'll provide you a disposable camera for you to capture and keep this special moment.

Reservations are required for this ride.

## SUNSET/TWILIGHT RIDE

Join us every Saturday night, weather permitting, starting July 2 through Labor Day Weekend, for an hour-long sunset/twilight ride along our horseback trails.
